

## 2011 Chalani Breeding Contract

2. **Service:** The mare \_\_\_\_\_ Breed \_\_\_\_\_  
Reg No \_\_\_\_\_ will be bred to the stallion **Splashdance** for the Service Fee of **\$880**.  
A non-refundable booking fee of **\$380** is to be paid in advance of natural service and will be deducted from the service fee (GST not applicable).

The full Service fee of **\$880** is to be paid in advance of shipment of Frozen Semen.

**All mares must arrive at Chalani unshod and in good health.**

3. **Accounts:** An Account listing all charges including the remainder of the service fee will be payable within seven days of positive pregnancy test, or upon removal of the mare from Chalani, whichever comes first. It is expected that the mare will be removed within seven days of notification of a positive pregnancy test.
4. **Agistment:** Agistment is charged at \$8 per day, payable two weeks in advance. This includes daily hay. If you wish to supply your own hay, agistment will be charged at \$6 per day, payable two weeks in advance. If supplied hay runs out and more is not supplied, agistment will be charged at \$8 per day. Other feed (supplied by owner) can be fed to the mare at a fee of \$1 per day. Any other special requirements are charged at \$1 per day (ie rugging, separate paddock/yard/foal at foot). Agistment fees after Christmas and prior to 1st September increase by \$2 per day.
5. **Veterinary Attention:** The mare shall be in a healthy and sound breeding condition, free from infections, contagious and or transmissible diseases. Inoculations, particularly tetanus and strangles are to be up to date. Vet fees with regard to the wellbeing of the mare, pregnancy testing, or to encourage a difficult breeder to conceive, are to be paid by the mare owner and will be billed directly to the mare owner. All mares are to be wormed within a week prior to arrival.
6. **Return Rights:** Should the mare slip or fail to produce a live foal, Chalani must be notified within 48 hours of foaling. A veterinary certificate confirming the mare is not in foal, or no live foal has been produced, may be requested. Chalani will accept the mare for free return service during the consecutive season only, upon payment of **\$380 booking fee**, to the same stallion, (or substitute stallion if the above horse is no longer available). Usual veterinary charges and agistment apply. If a mare is neglected or undergoes any veterinary interference which terminates the pregnancy (twinning excepted), or the mare is not returned to Chalani, this contract becomes null and void. If the stallion dies, frozen semen is not available or no substitute stallion is standing at stud at

Chalani, this contract becomes null and void. *No refunds will be given.* Re-breeding in the same stud season does not require additional booking fees to be paid.

7. **Approval of mares:** Preference will be given to mares arriving in early spring. It is recommended they arrive 'in season' and are removed following ultrasound confirmation of pregnancy 18 days after mating. Mares will be accepted after Christmas and before September *only in unusual circumstances*. Preference will be given to registered A.S.H. mares, or mares of proven performance or temperament. If a mare is considered to be an unlikely breeder another approved mare may be substituted. Mares may be run with the stallion, however hand service is usual. If in the opinion of Chalani a mare is of doubtful temperament or breeding type, Chalani will request her removal and all fees and accounts will become due and payable.
8. **Sale of in-foal mare:** If at the time of the sale the mare is no longer pregnant, or in good health, this contract becomes null and void. A veterinary certificate of pregnancy at the time of sale is recommended.
9. **Liability:** Whilst every care will be taken, Chalani shall not be liable for any accident or injury occasioned to the mare or her foal at foot, while at stud, nor will the mare owner be held responsible for any accident or injury occasioned to the stallion. Insurance of mares is recommended.
10. **Frozen Semen:** Where a mare owner elects to breed by Artificial Insemination with frozen semen, the Service fee is to be paid per nominated mare **in advance** and at least 2 days prior to the shipping of any semen. This fee must be paid to Chalani before semen is released from our storage point. The following conditions shall apply to the supply of frozen semen:
  - 10.1 The mare shall be in a healthy and sound breeding condition, free from infections, contagious and or transmissible diseases.
  - 10.2 All fees incurred by the mare owner are the responsibility of the mare owner alone.
  - 10.3 Cost of container hire and freight is payable by the mare owner. We take no responsibility for the shipment once it leaves our storage point. Check your insurance situation with the freight company.
  - 10.4 The Mare Owner must submit details of the mare, including any and all markings, branding, microchip number if applicable, a copy of pedigree papers and photographs. This information will be used when the mare is tested in foal and a service certificate can be issued. *Please ensure your own insemination veterinarian has a copy of these details as they may be required to sign the service certificate.*
  - 10.5 To ensure first rate results, the mare owner must source and nominate an experienced AI reproductive centre that specializes in handling frozen semen with confirmed results, to carry out the insemination procedure. Should the insemination procedure be carried out by an un-nominated, unauthorized and or inexperienced AI veterinary centre, this contract will be null and void with no loss or responsibility falling on Chalani.
  - 10.6 Chalani offers 2 straws per frozen semen dose. 3 doses will be dispatched, giving the mare owner three months to settle the mare in foal. No free return will be available if the frozen semen is used after this three month period, except as listed in the following point.
  - 10.7 If the mare conceives on the first dose, the remaining straws must be dispatched back to our storage point at the cost of the mare owner. If the mare owner wishes to keep the remaining straws for the following breeding season or would like to use the remaining straws on an additional (approved and nominated) mare, the full service fee price will be charged, for immediate payment, for use in the following breeding season or for an additional mare in the current season. However, the storage of the remaining straws will

be at the cost of the mare owner. The remaining straws must be kept in a suitable storage at the designated AI centre to ensure the quality of the semen is not compromised.

- 10.8 If the mare is unable to settle in foal using the three doses provided, an alternative mare (upon approval by Chalani) may be substituted as a replacement and a further three doses will be provided at **half price** with no doses thereafter being provided. Attendance of the mare for live service at Chalani instead of AI will be considered on a case by case basis.
- 10.9 The mare is to be scanned by 18 days after first insemination. If confirmed in foal, she must then be re-scanned at 45 days before a service certificate will be provided.
- 10.10 No responsibility or cost, whole or in part, for whatever reason will fall upon Chalani for loss of foal, at or after the 45 days scanning in utero. Free returns will only be accepted in the following breeding season upon payment of the booking fee.
- 11. Walk In Walk Off:** Walk in – Walk off of a mare to be live served is acceptable, providing all booking and service fees are paid prior to service. The mare and the Mare owner is subject to all conditions listed in this contract.
- 12. Embryo Transfer:** If the nominated mare is to be used for embryo transfer the mare owner must clearly declare this, in this contract. The mare owner is to supply registration papers and/or identity details of the recipient mare to Chalani. A veterinary certificate must be provided to Chalani specifying the details and dates of the embryo transfer into the recipient mare.
- 13. Service Certificate:** All progeny of ASH Stallions may apply to be registered with the Australian Stock Horse Society upon payment of ASH membership fee, registration fee, and presentation of the official Stallion Service Certificate. Foals produced by Artificial Semen need to undergo DNA testing as part of the ASH registration process.

**An ASH service certificate will be supplied following positive pregnancy test of the mare.**

Progeny of ANSA registered stallions, from ANSA registered mares, are eligible to apply for ANSA foal recording.
